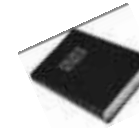
The food pantry is open on Wednesday and Sunday.

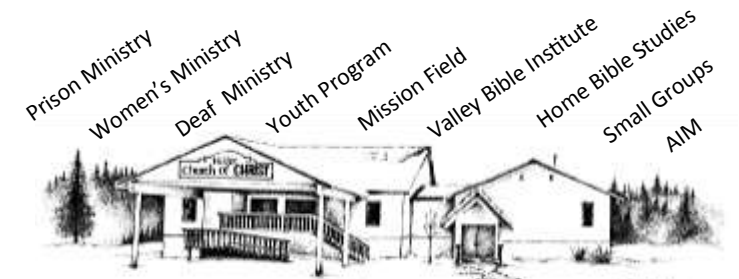
