Our congregation has been asked to supply 30 dozen cookies for the Lectureship. There is a sign up sheet on the bulletin board. See Melinda Crockett for more information.

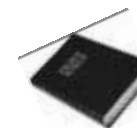

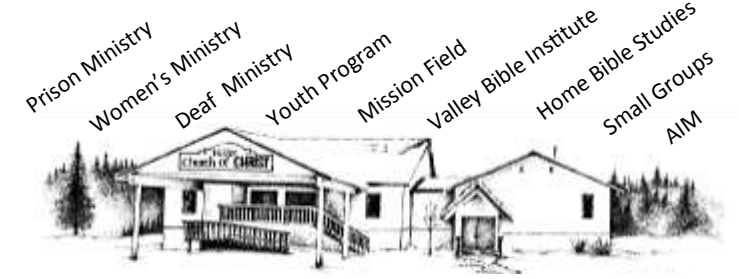
