*“Behold, days are coming,” declares the LORD, “when I will make a new covenant...”* Jeremiah 31:31

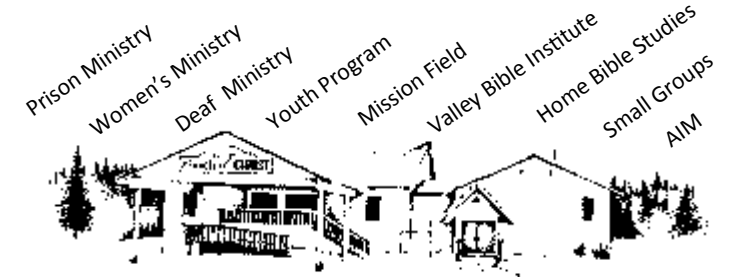
- > It’s a BETTER Covenant – Hebrews 8:6
