 about the New Covenant is better!!!!

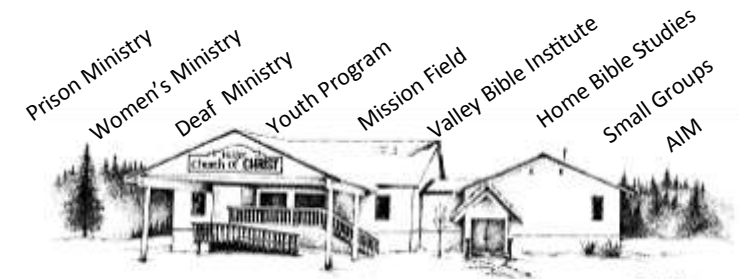
