We are requesting 5 or 6 men (and/or boys, can be fathers and son) to help with setup, serving and cleanup during the meals of the Ladies’ Retreat.

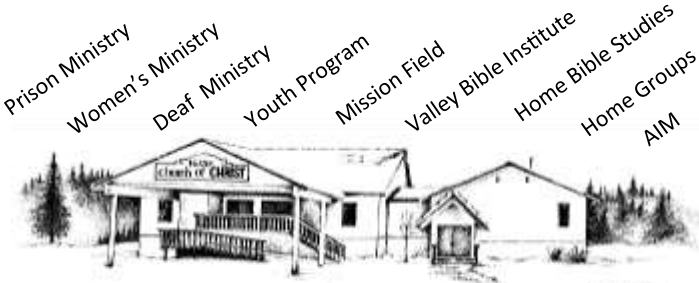
