My name is Jordan Bertram and I am excited to announce that I have been accepted into the Sunset International Bible Institute School of Preaching (SIBI). I will be attending Sunset starting in August of 2019 and will be moving down to Lubbock Texas over the summer.

Having recently graduated from the Adventures in Missions (AIM) program, I was blessed to work with several families, churches, and organizations across North America and 18 months in Wasilla, Alaska. From this I have found that I have a strong desire to serve the Lord in whatever capacity that I can. I feel that, at this time, attending Sunset will help equip me to have a better understanding of the scriptures as well as presenting me with many opportunities of leadership, mentorship, teaching, and evangelism.

The School of preaching program lasts two to three years depending on class load with options to serve in internships with both churches and missions, as well as many other service work opportunities.

Sunset is entirely tuition free, with the only cost associated with the school being for books and supplies. However, while attending students still need to be able to cover the cost of living in Lubbock which will run about twelve-hundred dollars a month.

What I know is that God can do great things through His people working together.

**... One Baptism ...**  
(Part I)

In Ephesians 4:5 the Bible teaches us that for the church there is ONE BAPTISM. Lets learn what Baptism is and what it does. In Acts 8:36-38 we see that Baptism is immersion in water. The word Baptism in the original Greek means “immerse”. The Bible teaches a great deal about it.

- Jesus clearly taught that it was necessary – **Mark 16:16**
- Jesus taught His followers to perform it and teach everyone. – **Matthew 28:19-20**
- Jesus exemplified it – **Matthew 3:13-17, Mark 1:9-11**
- The Apostles taught it at their first opportunity – **Acts 2:19-42**
- They taught that it would apply to everyone – **Matthew 28:19, Acts 2:38-39**
- They taught that its necessity would continue for all time – **Acts 2:39**
- It was applied in all conversions even when Apostles were surprised – **Acts 10:47-48**
- The History of Early church growth (Acts) gives many examples - **Acts 2:24; 8:12, 13, 38; 9:18; 10:48; 16:15, 33; 18:8; 19:5**
- Sometimes Baptism was commanded by the teacher – **Acts 22:16**
- Sometimes Baptism was requested by the student – **Acts 8:36**
- It was such a natural part of the teaching that sometimes it wasn’t even mentioned in the written Word; but it was obeyed - **Acts 8:12-13, 8:35-38; 16:15, 16:31-33, 18:8**
