... One Baptism ...^{Eph 4:5}
 (Part I)

The Bible teaches that Baptism is A necessary step to our SALVATION:

- Jesus clearly taught that it was – Mark 16:16
 - Jesus taught His followers to perform it (for everyone) – Matthew 28:19
 - Jesus taught His followers to teach it (to everyone) – Matthew 28:20
 - Jesus exemplified it – Matthew 3:13-17, Mark 1:9-11
 - The Apostles taught it at their first opportunity – Acts 2:19-42
 - They taught that it would apply to everyone – Matthew 28:19, Acts 2:38-39
 - They taught that its necessity would continue for all time – Acts 2:39
 - It was applied in all conversions even when Apostles were surprised – Acts 10:47-48
 - The History of Early church growth (Acts) gives many examples - Acts 2:24; 8:12, 13, 38; 9:18; 10:48; 16:15, 33; 18:8; 19:5
 - Sometimes Baptism was commanded by the teacher – Acts 22:16
 - Sometimes Baptism was requested by the student – Acts 8:36
 - It was such a natural part of the teaching that sometimes it wasn't even mentioned in the written Word; but it was obeyed - Acts 8:12-13, 8:35-38; 16:15, 16:31-33, 18:8
- EPH 4:3-6** – The New Testament teaches that there is only ONE BAPTISM for the Christian. Don't let traditions and added teachings mislead you.
