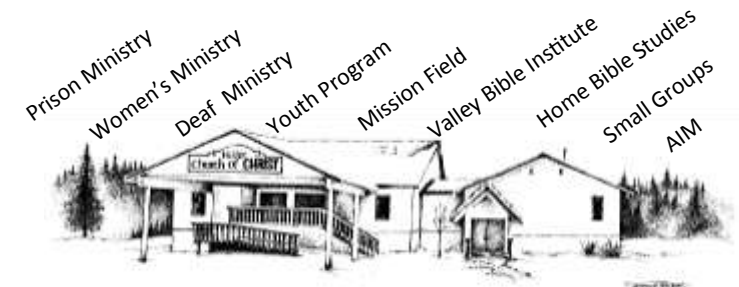


**ALASKA LECTURESHIP**
