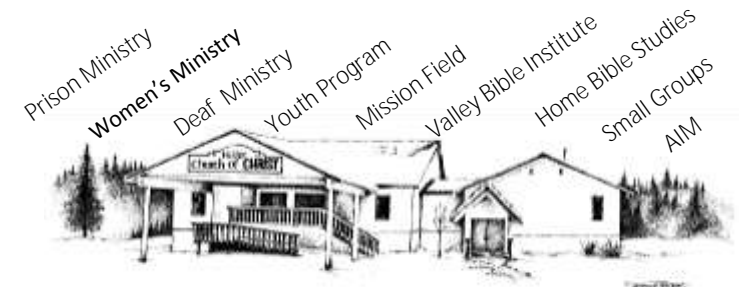


ALASKA LECTURESHIP
