 God adds those baptized to His church – Acts 2:42-47

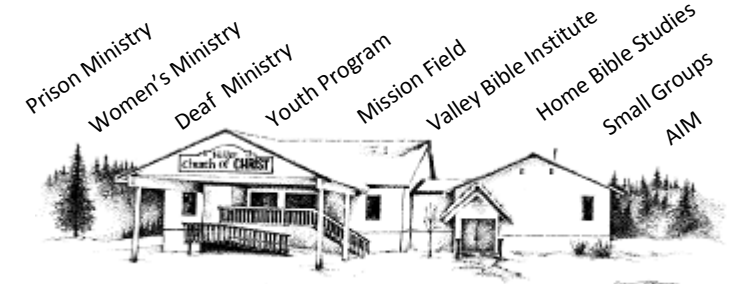
