<u>... One Baptism ...</u>

(Part I)

In Ephesians 4:5 the Bible teaches us that for the church there is <u>ONE BAPTISM</u>. Lets learn what Baptism is and what it does. In Acts 8:36-38 we see that Baptism is immersion in water. The word Baptism in the original Greek means "immerse". The Bible teaches a great deal about it.

- Jesus clearly taught that it was necessary – Mark 16:16

- Jesus taught His followers to perform it and teach everyone. – <u>Matthew 28:19-20</u>
- Jesus exampled it Matthew 3:13-17, Mark 1:9-11
- The Apostles taught it at their first opportunity <u>Acts 2:19-42</u>

- They taught that it would apply to everyone – Matthew 28:19, Acts 2:38-39

- They taught that its necessity would continue for all time – <u>Acts 2:39</u>

- It was applied in all conversions even when Apostles were surprised – <u>Acts 10:47-48</u>
- The History of Early church growth (Acts) gives many examples - <u>Acts 2:24; 8:12, 13, 38; 9:18; 10:48;</u> <u>16:15, 33; 18:8; 19:5</u>

- Sometimes Baptism was commanded by the teacher – <u>Acts 22:16</u>

- Sometimes Baptism was requested by the student – <u>Acts 8:36</u>

 It was such a natural part of the teaching that sometimes it wasn't even mentioned in the written Word; but it was obeyed Acts 8:12-13,8:35-38; 16:15, 16:31-33, 18:8
