... One Baptism ... Eph 4:5 (Part II)

Baptism was taught to the early church in a great variety of ways.

- Jesus gave us Baptism as a clear part of our teaching the lost – <u>Matthew 28-18-20, Mark 16:16</u>

 Baptism was mostly described in relation to Christ – <u>Romans 6:3-7; 1Corinthians 1:13-17;</u> <u>Galatians 3:27; Colossians 2:12</u>

 Baptism was connected to Old Testament scriptures and events -<u>1 Corinthians 10:2, 1 Peter 3:20-21</u>

 It was presumed (known) that all in the church had been baptized - <u>Romans 6:3-5, 1 Corinthians 1:13-</u> <u>17; Galatians 3:27; Colossians 2:12 etc.</u>

Peter taught what baptism isn't - <u>1 Peter 3:21</u>

 Baptism was so second nature that it became to be emphasized and bragged about in the wrong way – 1 Corinthians 1:13-17

 Baptism was used to describe not only our connection to Jesus but to His Body, the church – <u>1 Corinthians 12:13</u>

- Baptism was emphasized so much that some failed to move on to learn about more mature subjects as they should – <u>Hebrews 6:1-2</u>

 People were taught to get baptized right away – <u>Acts 22:16</u>

- Believers who hadn't been, would be taught to be baptized correctly— <u>Acts 18:24 – 19:5</u>

- Baptism would be taught about both literally and symbolically – <u>Acts 8:35-38; John 3:3-5;</u> <u>1John 5:5-7, Rom 6:3-5</u>

- The Bible CLEARLY says Baptism is required (!!!) – Mark16:16; Acts 2:38; 22:16;1 Peter 3:21

- **<u>EPHESIANS 4:3-6</u>** – The New Testament teaches that There is only ONE BAPTISM for the Christian.

Don't let traditions and added teachings mislead you.
